Remote Learning Option:

- Elementary students receive remote instruction through an assigned Nebo remote learning teacher
 - Primary instruction focusing on reading, writing, mathematics, and science with supplemental support in other curricular areas
- Secondary students will receive instruction through Utah Students Connect courses
 - o All required courses and many elective courses available
- Parent tutorials and videos will be provided for Canvas
- Individualized Education Program (IEP) and 504 plans may require the IEP or 504 team to reconvene
