

HOW TO NAVIGATE A CONTINUOUS FLOW INTERSECTION (CFI)


As part of the I-15 Corridor Expansion (I-15 CORE), UDOT is redesigning the intersection at University Parkway and Sandhill Road. This new Continuous Flow Intersection (CFI) is the first of its kind in Utah County and will increase the number of vehicles that can move through the intersection. The CFI is scheduled to open on May 22, 2012.

MAKING A LEFT TURN AT THE NEW CFI AT UNIVERSITY PARKWAY IS AS EASY AS 1-2-3

- 1. Start by lining up in the left turn lane like normal intersections, only a little farther back. If you are coming from northbound I-15, the new off-ramp signal will create gaps in traffic to make it easier to move across lanes to the left.
- **2**. When the left turn signal turns green, drive across the oncoming lanes into an all new lane on the far left side of the road.
- **3**. Another left turn signal will then tell you when you can go ahead and make your left turn.



Proceed as you normally would, but watch for another light just past the intersection. It's possible to encounter a red light here, which allows left-turning cars to cross in front of you.

Be sure to yield to traffic, cyclists and pedestrians. Make your turn, merge with traffic and keep on going.



LEFT TURNS (onto University Parkway):

Proceed just like a normal intersection, but watch for another light just past the intersection. You may see a red light here, which allows left-turning cars to cross in front of you.
