Nebo Peak Center Opens

The Nebo Peak Center opened its doors for fall of 2017 at 161 East 400 North in Salem. Administrator, Ben Ford, welcomed over 200 guests on August 21. Superintendent Rick Nielsen and school board member, Rick Ainge, spoke of the vision for the new facility that includes the Advanced Learning Center (ALC), Fieldhouse, Warehouse, and Maintenance buildings.

The ALC is a 49,000 square foot floor space that provides early college and career courses to high school students while students stay involved at their primary school. ALC offers aviation, computer programming and repair, digital media, audio engineering, video production, medical science, criminal



justice, building construction, engineering, robotics, manufacturing, and teacher education courses.

The Fieldhouse is a 82,000 square foot floor space that contains a track, softball, baseball, batting, pitching, soccer, football, golf, and volleyball areas.

The Warehouse is 48,800 square feet, and the Maintenance Building is 70,000 square feet.

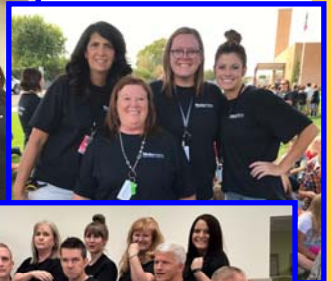
