Have you always wondered how to paint/draw faces? This is your opportunity to learn! This is a 6 week class focusing on painting portraits from neck/shoulders up. We will use live models in class, as media to draw/paint from.

All abilities are welcome. We take a step by step approach to drawing and painting the face/portrait so no one will be left behind.

Beginners start working in pencil, then move onto oil. Those with drawing and oil experience start painting portraits in oil immediately.

3. Fitness Classes

5. Hunter Safety

The Utah Hunter Education program helps you learn essential safety skills and develop practical techniques useful for hunting. Completion of a basic hunter education course is required to obtain a hunting license in Utah if you were born after Dec. 31, 1965. Students are required to obtain a voucher (cost \$10.00) at a license agent for the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources, prior to registering for a Hunter Education course. Upon successful completion of the course, the license will allow a Hunter Education graduate to hunt small game during the current season. The Hunter Education card, commonly known as the “Blue Card” will be mailed to the student at the address provided on the voucher.
