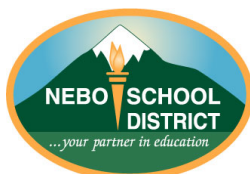

Class or Activity Description

1. American Sign Language (A.S.L.) ages 12 and up SHHS E-100

An introduction to American Sign Language that will leave you able to hold brief, yet meaningful conversations with those in The Deaf community. By the end of the course you will be challenged to share a personal experience entirely in sign. A great course for parents/guardians who have children learning ASL. Paul Erwin will be the instructor for this 6 week course.

2. Dance, Ballroom – ages 8 and up SHHS Dance Studio A-117

Can anyone learn how to ballroom dance? YES! This class is fun and designed for beginners. The more experienced dancers are invited also. Dancing gives a couple a lifetime hobby. These dances are great for social settings such as school dances, weddings and office parties. There are lots of styles of partner dance to choose from. Singles and couples invited. It is more convenient to have a dance partner so ask someone and come on out!

Instruction includes: Swing, Fox Trot, Waltz, Polka, and a “couples line dance” from the Pilgrim Era in the 1600 hundreds (Virginal Reel), etc. This Ballroom class is for 5 consecutive weeks on Tuesdays from 8:00 to 9:00 pm beginning Tuesday Jan. 16, 2018.

3. Gold Prospecting age 18 & up Wednesday, February 28, 2018 ONE NIGHT ONLY

A fortune in gold is just waiting out there to be found! Learn the secrets to locating and collecting gold. Come learn how to locate gold and the best techniques for both collecting and cleaning it. You will learn some secrets about the most common gold tools and the appropriate use of each. Hands-on experience will be provided in addition to the resources that will help you dramatically increase your chances of finding that next pay day! 4. Hunter Safety

The Utah Hunter Education program helps you learn essential safety skills and develop practical techniques useful for hunting. Completion of a basic hunter education course is required to obtain a hunting license in Utah if you were born after Dec. 31, 1965. Students are required to obtain a voucher (cost \$10.00) at a license agent for the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources, prior to registering for a Hunter Education course. Upon successful completion of the course, the license will allow a Hunter Education graduate to hunt small game during the current season. The Hunter Education card, commonly known as the “Blue Card” will be mailed to the student at the address provided on the voucher.

5. Personal / Family Finance SHHS Rm C 108 ONE NIGHT ONLY

Personal/Family Finance All ages invited. **SHHS Room C 108.** This is a 2 hour seminar offered for one evening from 7:00 to 9:00 pm on Thursday, February 1, 2018.

6. Photography & Photoshop – Beginning ages 18 and up SHHS Rm C-102

This is a 5 week course covering the essential BASICS of Photography & Photoshop, a must for every Digital Photographer. If you have been thinking about learning more about photography, how to take better pictures and do simple edits to make them simply amazing then this is the class for you. We will cover an introductory look at digital photography. You will learn how to work your digital camera, how to take a better picture, and some basic Photoshop skills. We will be using computers so you should have basic computer skills. Be sure and bring your digital camera (*SLR preferred*) and its manual. If you do not have a digital camera don’t let that stop you from taking the class. I have one for you to use in class. We will be working with high end computers and Adobe Photoshop. Kendall Call is the instructor for this 5 week class. This class fills up quickly (limit 20 students).

7. Quilting – Moda “Love Quilt” ages 18 and up Tuesday SHHS Rm #F-103

This quilt is super simple to make! “Sew” perfect for the beginner. This “Love Quilt” goes together really fast! Very little fabric waste. This is a great quilt for snuggling with your favorite person! Bring your layer cake, background fabric, rotary cutter, matching thread, and basic sewing kit with pins. Brandi Mascher will be the instructor for this 4 week class.

8. Writing a Novel ages 16 and up Wednesday SHHS Rm #C-106

Do you have an idea for a novel but don't know where to start? Have you worked your way through one before but felt like it was missing the oomph it needed to shine? This six-week course will equip you with the knowledge to finally write a book you can be proud of. Topics will include outlining vs. discovering writing, point of view, genre conventions, setting choice, world building, character development, scene/sequel, plot structure, description, and dialogue. Bring a laptop or notebook/pen for in-class workshops alongside each week's presentation. And most of all, bring your story ideas! This course is intended for beginning/intermediate writers.
