Tool Technician

Purpose Statement

The job of Tool Technician is done for the purpose/s of assisting the Automotive Instructor maintain, inventory, and check-out tools to students and staff.

This job is distinguished from similar jobs by the following characteristics: .

This job reports to the Principal

Essential Functions

- Assist students to learn how to identify and use tools under the direction of the automotive instructor for the purpose of facilitating the learning process and correct use of tools.
- Maintain an organized, clean, safe and secure tool room for the purpose of making tools available for instructional purposes of the automotive program.
- Monitor student use of tools and equipment (e.g. check-out and in tools, check for damaged tools, etc.) for the purpose of preserving tools for educational purposes.

Other Functions

• Perform other related duties, as assigned, for the purpose of ensuring the efficient and effective functioning of the work unit.

Job Requirements: Minimum Qualifications

Skills, Knowledge and Abilities

SKILLS are required to perform single tasks with a potential need to upgrade skills in order to meet changing job conditions. Specific skill based competencies required to satisfactorily perform the functions of the job include: adhering to safety practices; operating equipment used; preparing and maintaining accurate records; using pertinent software applications.

KNOWLEDGE is required to perform basic math, including calculations using fractions, percents, and/or ratios; understand written procedures, write routine documents, and speak clearly; and understand multi-step written and oral instructions. Specific knowledge based competencies required to satisfactorily perform the functions of the job include: concepts of grammar and punctuation; safety practices and procedures; basic knowledge of automotive tools.

ABILITY is required to schedule activities; collate data; and use job-related equipment. Flexibility is required to work with others; work with data utilizing specific, defined processes; and operate equipment using standardized methods. Ability is also required to work with others; work with specific, job-related data; and utilize job-related equipment. Some problem solving may be required to identify issues and select action plans. Problem solving with data requires following prescribed guidelines; and problem solving with equipment is limited. Specific ability based competencies required to satisfactorily perform the functions of the job include: displaying mechanical aptitude; working as part of a team; communicating with students and staff; and working with frequent interruptions Have the Ability for regular and reliable attendance.

Responsibility

Responsibilities include: working with immediate supervision; providing information and/or advising others; operating within a defined budget. Utilization of some resources from other work units may be required to perform the job's functions. There is some opportunity to effect the organization's services.

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Working Environment

The usual and customary methods of performing the job's functions require the following physical demands: significant lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling, some climbing and balancing, frequent stooping, kneeling, crouching, and/or crawling and significant fine finger dexterity. Generally the job requires 10% sitting, 30% walking, and 60% standing. The job is performed under minimal temperature variations and in a clean atmosphere.
