- STAY POSITIVE during the trial and error of your own learning.

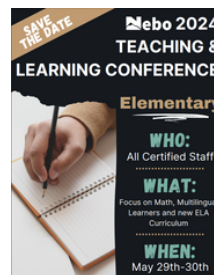

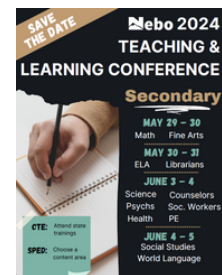

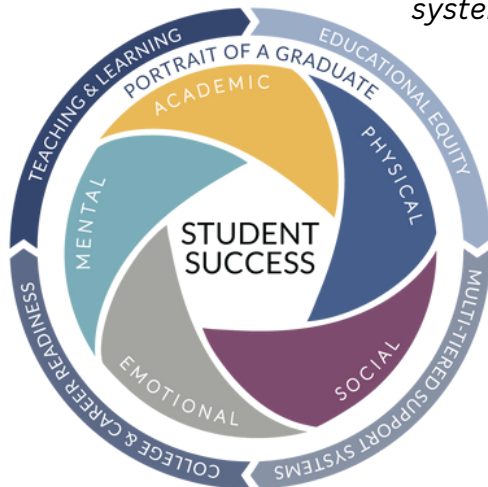
