Class or Activity Descriptions

Art Class: Oil Painting for Adults (ages 18 and up)

Fitness Classes: Power Pump & Zumba

Monday - Power Pump: This class combines the power of high intensity cardio intervals, bodyweight exercises, core exercises and weight lifting for maximum fitness results.

Quilting Class: Quilting T-Shirt Quilt (ages 18 & up)

Do you have t-shirts full of memories from family vacations? school activities, or t-shirts that no one is wearing? Then take a walk down memory lane and create a personalized quilt from your old shirts. These quilts are the perfect special-occasion gift. Holly Jensen is the instructor for this 4-week class. Supplies needed: 12 to 15 t-shirts. Additional supply list will be given at the first class. We will be using the mats and rulers at the high school.

Class dates: Feb. 3, 10, 17, 24 Time: 6:30pm to 9:00pm PHS Room #C-13

Welding: (ages 18 & up)

This is a welding class where you will be taught the basics of SMAW (stick) welding, GMAW (MIG) welding, GTAW (TIG) welding, plasma cutting, and oxy-fuel cutting. Items you will be required to bring to each session include: leather welding gloves, safety glasses, pliers, and coveralls or welding jacket. Each session will include basic information and demonstration of the process and then include individual process practice. Materials will be provided for the practice of each process. After the initial classes, time will be allotted for you to work on an individual project of your own design and choosing. Project materials for the class will not be provided. Shaun Black is the instructor for this 8-week class.
